Hickory Wind played and recorded to critical acclaim from 1973 until 1978, touring and sharing the stage with such luminaries as Doc Watson, John Prine, John Hartford, Nitty Gritty Dirt Band, and Bonnie Raitt and releasing two highly regarded albums, **At the Midnight Waltz** on the Adelphi label and **Fresh Produce** on the Flying Fish label.

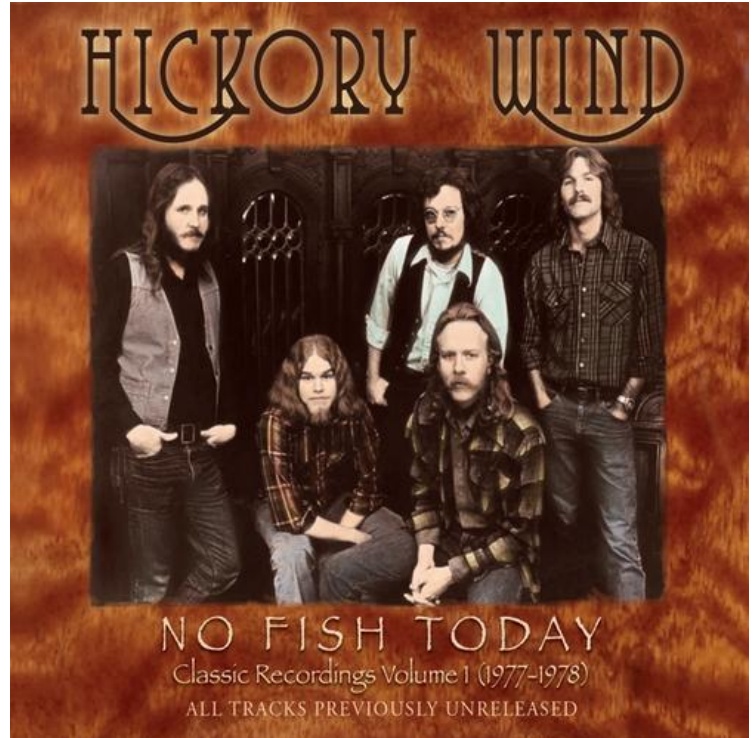
They disbanded after 6 years, on the eve of the release of a third album, **Crossing Devil's Bridge**, to pursue other interests.

Now, more than 30 years later, original members Sam Morgan (fiddle, mandolin, guitar, vocals); Bob Shank (five-string banjo, hammered dulcimer, vocals); Mark Walbridge (vocals, guitar, bouzouki); and Glen McCarthy (electric bass, vocals) have reunited and are touring once again.

In December 2009, the band released an album of previously unreleased tracks from 1977 and 1978, **No Fish Today**, on CD and as MP3s.

Founding member Bob Shank appeared for the Community Coffee House on February 22nd, 2014. For this concert, **Hickory Wind** will play selections from its three vinyl recordings of the 1970s, the retrospective CD **No Fish Today**, and Shank's 2012 release **Don't Worry About the Moon**; along with traditional and original material that crosses and melds musical genres.
