
Hildebrand present *Baltimore in 1814: A Concert*

Bob Shank, founding member of the legendary bluegrass group Hickory Wind, has been a benchmark for American acoustic instrumentalists for more than three decades. A sixth-generation West Virginian, Bob began his musical journey at age 5 with drums and piano and, by age 13, was firmly hooked on banjo, and then he mastered guitar, and then hammered dulcimer. 
March 1 2014, Saturday - 7:30 PM – Cathy Fink and Marcy Marxer

Hickory Wind played and recorded to critical acclaim from 1973 until 1978, touring and sharing the stage with such luminaries as John Prine, John Hartford, Nitty Gritty Dirt Band, and Bonnie Raitt and releasing three highly regarded albums on the Flying Fish label. They disbanded after 5 years to pursue other interests and now, more than 30 years later, original members Bob Shank, Mark Walbridge, Sam Morgan, and Glen McCarthy have reunited and are touring once again.
